Chord Sheet

The Following are some of the more commonly used chords. If you need a chord on a note that is not in this chart (i.e., Eb major), use the chord above or below (E or D) and make each note in the chord one-half step flat or one-half step sharp (EbGBb or D#GA#). You will need to know both names for all the notes on your dulcimer (i.e., D# is Eb, A# is Bb, and even things like F## is G, G#b is G, E# is F, etc.).
